
Hi! Boots and I are playing soccer today.

Let's go!




Oh, no! There are two trails. Which track should we take? Let's look at the tree trunks. Map said to go past the Bumpy Tree Trunk. Come on!




Here is the Grumpy

Let's try to solve it!




He says: "You play this game with your feet, not your hands. Kick the ball and make a goal if you can." Do you know the answer? Right! It's soccer.
