Hood.



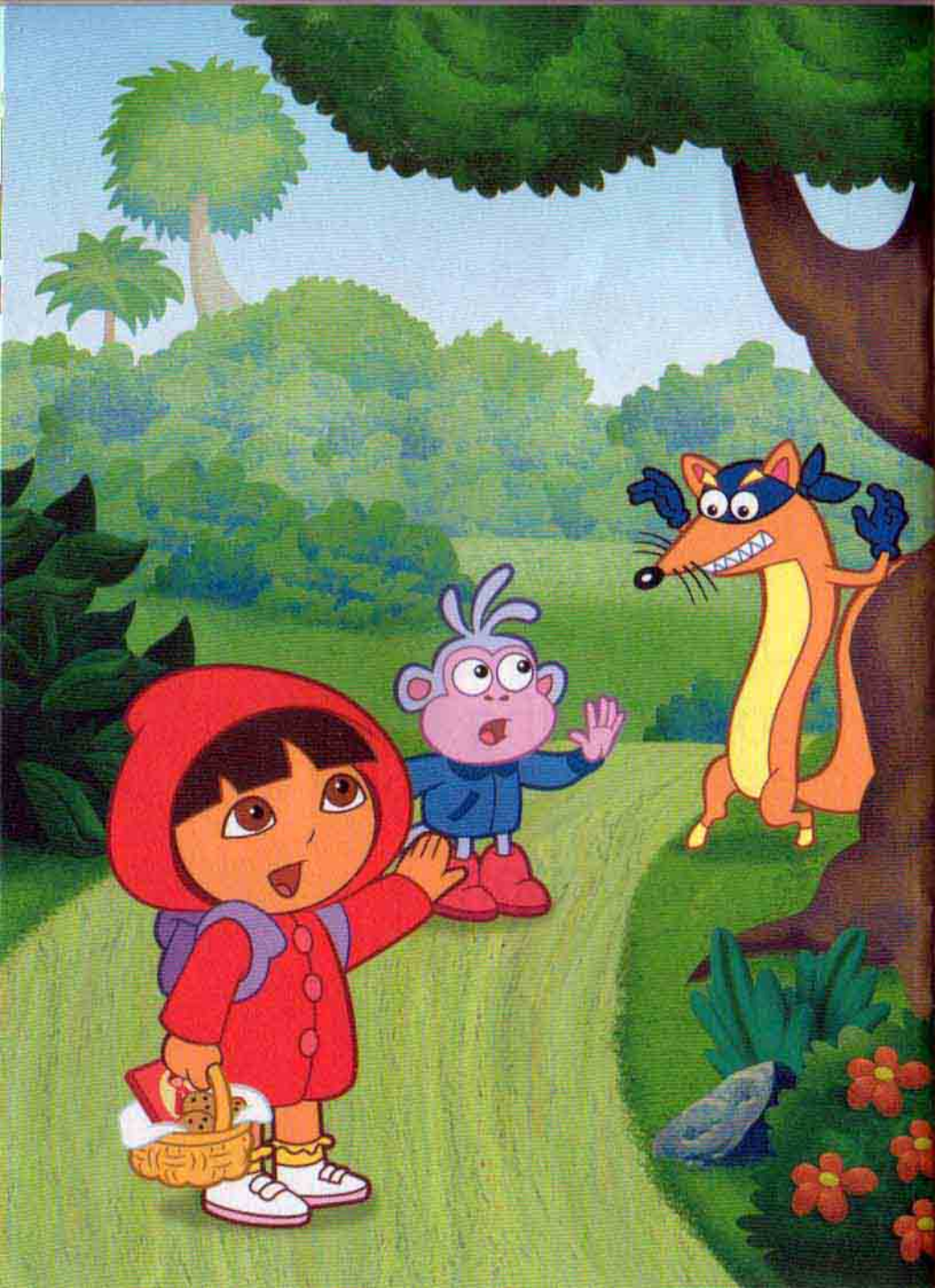
Which way should we go?
