





"Time to get up!" said Barbie.


"We are going to the fair!"

"I can ride by myself."





When they got to the fair, Kelly ran to the Ferris wheel. 10




She looked up, up, up at the Ferris wheel.

It was very big.







"Are you ready to ride the Ferris wheel?" asked Barbie. "Not yet," said Kelly.



"Are you ready to ride the Ferris wheel?" asked Barbie.






She petted a cow.




She even fed hay to a goat.

She waved to Barbie.




"Are you ready to ride the Ferris wheel now?" asked Barbie.

Kelly and Barbie watched the Ferris wheel go around and around.










"Kelly, do you want me to ride with you?" asked Barbie.
