Did you know? Sao Tome and Principe gained Independence from Portugal on July 12, 1975. Portuguese remains the official language of this 372-square mile island nation off the west coast of Africa.

Did you know? A national holiday in the Solomon Islands commemorates its independence from Britain on July 7, 1978.



Did you know? The Republic of Vanuatu was formed on July 1980. France and the UK previously governed these South Pacific islands, located east of Australia. Reflecting its history, Bislama, English, and French are all official languages. Just 200,000 people live in Vanuatu.



Did you know? Venezuela proclaimed its independence from Spain on July 5, 1811. The country became a nation 10 years later. Venezuela's capital is Caracas. The country, located at the north of South America, has rich oil and other mineral resources.



To color the flag of Puerto Rico, use Crayola® crayons, markers, or colored pencils. Color the shapes numbered 1 red. Color the shape numbered 2 blue. Leave the rest of the flag white.


Did you know? July 25th is Constitution Day in Puerto Rico because on this date in 1952 this island in the West Indies became a self-governing commonwealth of the United States. Puerto Rican people have Taino, Spanish, and African heritage. Columbus landed on the island in 1493 and named it San Juan. San Juan became the name of Puerto Rico's capital when the island's name was changed to Puerto Rico, which means Rich Port.



To color the flag of South Korea, use Crayola® crayons, colored pencils or markers. Color the top half of the circle red and bottom blue. Leave the rest white.

Did you know?

The South Korean flag has four sets of broken and unbroken bars. The top left set, called Kun, means heaven, the bottom left set, Yi, means fire, the bottom right set, Kon, means earth, and the top right set, Kam, means water. All of these elements together stand for harmony and peace.





To color the flag of Switzerland, use Crayola® crayons, colored pencils or markers. Color the background red and leave the cross white.

Did you know?

Switzerland has been inhabited by the Helvetii earlier than 58 B.C.E. The year 1291 marks the year of a confederation pact between the cantons Schwyz, Uri, and Unterwalden. The legendary character William Tell was supposed to have had a role in this pact.



To color the flag of Macedonia, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the circle and rays yellow and the background red.

Did you know?

Macedonia used to be a part of the republic of Yugoslavia. Macedonia is found in the southeastern area of Europe. It is on the Balkan Peninsula.

Did you know?

Niger was a republic of the French Community in 1958, and gained total independence from France on August 3, 1960. Niger is found in western Africa. Children in Niger attend school between the ages of 7 and 15.



To color the flag of Burkina Faso, use Crayola® crayons, colored pencils or markers. Color the background green. For the corner stripes color the first strip red, the second black, and the third gold. Color the eagle gold.

Did you know?

Burkina Faso, also known as Upper Volta) gained its independence from France in 1960. Burkina Faso is a little bit larger than the United State Colorado.



To color the flag of Zambia, use Crayola® crayons, colored pencils or markers. Color the background green. For the corner stripes color the first strip red, the second black, and the third gold. Color the eagle gold.

Did you know?

Zambia(Northern Rhodesia) was first ruled by the South Africa Company in 1891, until the United Kingdom took control in 1923. Zambia gained independence in 1964, and named itself Zambia.



To color the flag of Singapore, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top stripe red and leave the moon, stars, and bottom stripe white.

Did you know?

Due to its location, Singapore was used as a supply point or rest area for sea traders. Singapore used to be a part of Malaysia until it broke apart and gained independence in 1965.



To color the flag of Cote D'Ivoire, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the left stripe orange, leave the second stripe white, and the right stripe green.

Did you know?

Cote D'Ivoire is located in West Africa on the Atlantic Ocean, between Ghana and Liberia. It is a very small country but very prosperous.



To color the flag of Jamaica, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top and bottom triangles green, the side triangles black, and X shape yellow.

Did you know?

Jamaica is the third largest island in the Caribbean. England had control of Jamaica since they first came to the Americas. Jamaica gained its independence in 1962.



To color the flag of Bolivia, use Crayola® crayons, colored pencils or markers. Color the top stripe and circle orange and the bottom stripe green.

Did you know?


Bolivia was named after the independence fighter Simon Bolivar, and is located in Central South America. Bolivia gained its independence from Spain on August 6, 1825, and currently has a population of over eight million people.



To color the flag of Cape Verde, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top and bottom stripe blue. Color the middle stripe red. Color the stars yellow and leave the rest white.

Did you know?

Cape Verde is located of the western coast of Africa. All of the islands combined measure slightly larger than Rhode Island, one of the smallest United States.



To color the flag of Chad, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top left stripe blue, the middle stripe yellow, and the right stripe red.

Did you know?

Chad is located in western Africa. Chad became independent from the French Equatorial Africa in 1960. People have been living in Chad as early as 500 B.C.E. In 1989, Chad formed a constitution which stated that the country is governed by a president and National Assembly.



To color the flag of Ecuador, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top strip yellow, the middle strip red, and the bottom stripe red.

Did you know?

Many artifacts have been found in Ecuador dating as early as 3,500 B.C.E. This community grew and created large cities along the coast by 500 B.C.E. These people created some of the oldest known pottery.



To color the flag of India, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top stripe orange and the bottom stripe green. Color the wheel navy blue. Leave the rest white.

Did you know?

The orange stripe represents courage and sacrifice, the white means purity, and the green means faith. The wheel is called the Chakra, which is Sanskrit for wheel or disk.



To color the flag of Gabon, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the top stripe green the middle stripe yellow and the bottom stripe blue.

Did you know?

The name Gabon came from the Portugese word gabao, which is a coat with the sleeve and hood that resembles the shape of the Como River area.



To color the flag of Central African Republic, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the star and bottom stripe yellow, the top stripe blue, the stripe above the bottom stripe green, and the stripe that runs from top to bottom red.

Did you know?

Central African Republic used to be called Ubangi-Shari before it became independent from France in 1960.



To color the flag of the Ukraine, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color top stripe sky blue and the bottom stripe yellow.

Did you know?

Ukraine used to be a part of the Soviet Union until it became independent in 1991.



To color the flag of Afghanistan, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color top stripe green leaving the letters white. Color the bottom stripe black and leave the middle stripe white.

Did you know?

Afghanistan used to be called Ariana or Bactia before it became independent from France in 1960.



To color the flag of the Moldova, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the stripe on the right navy blue, the middle stripe yellow, and the left stripe red. Color the top half of the shield red and the bottom half navy blue. Color the bull and eagle yellow.

Did you know?

Moldova declared its independence from the Soviet Union in 1991.



To color the flag of the Uruguay, use Crayola® Crayons, Colored Pencils or Markers. Color the sun yellow and the stripes cornflower blue. Leave the rest white.

Did you know?

Uruguay is located in southern South America. It is slightly smaller than the U.S. state of Washington.
