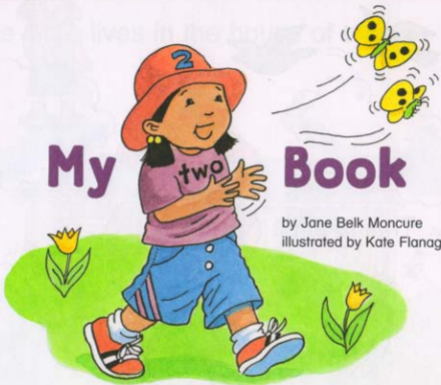

two shoes

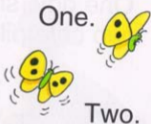
and goes for a walk.

Then the hens flew away.

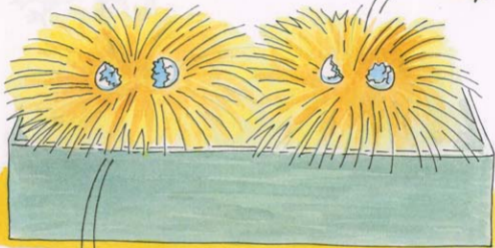


Little two saw two eggs.

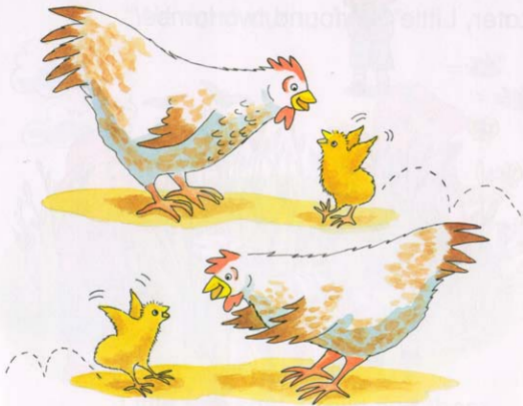


Guess what?

Next Little two found . . .

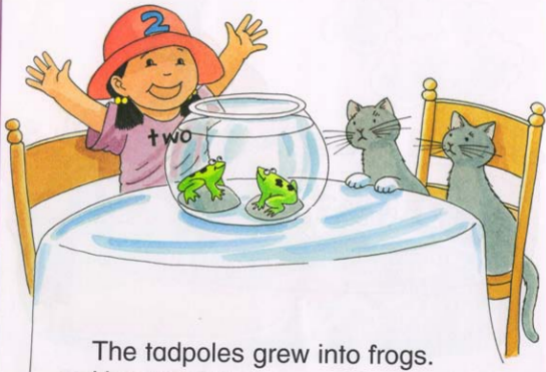


two tadpoles.

two stars in the sky.

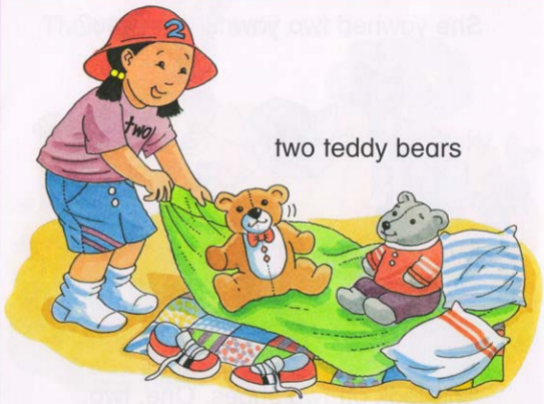


"I must go home," she said.

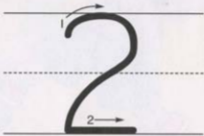

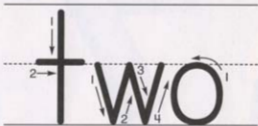
