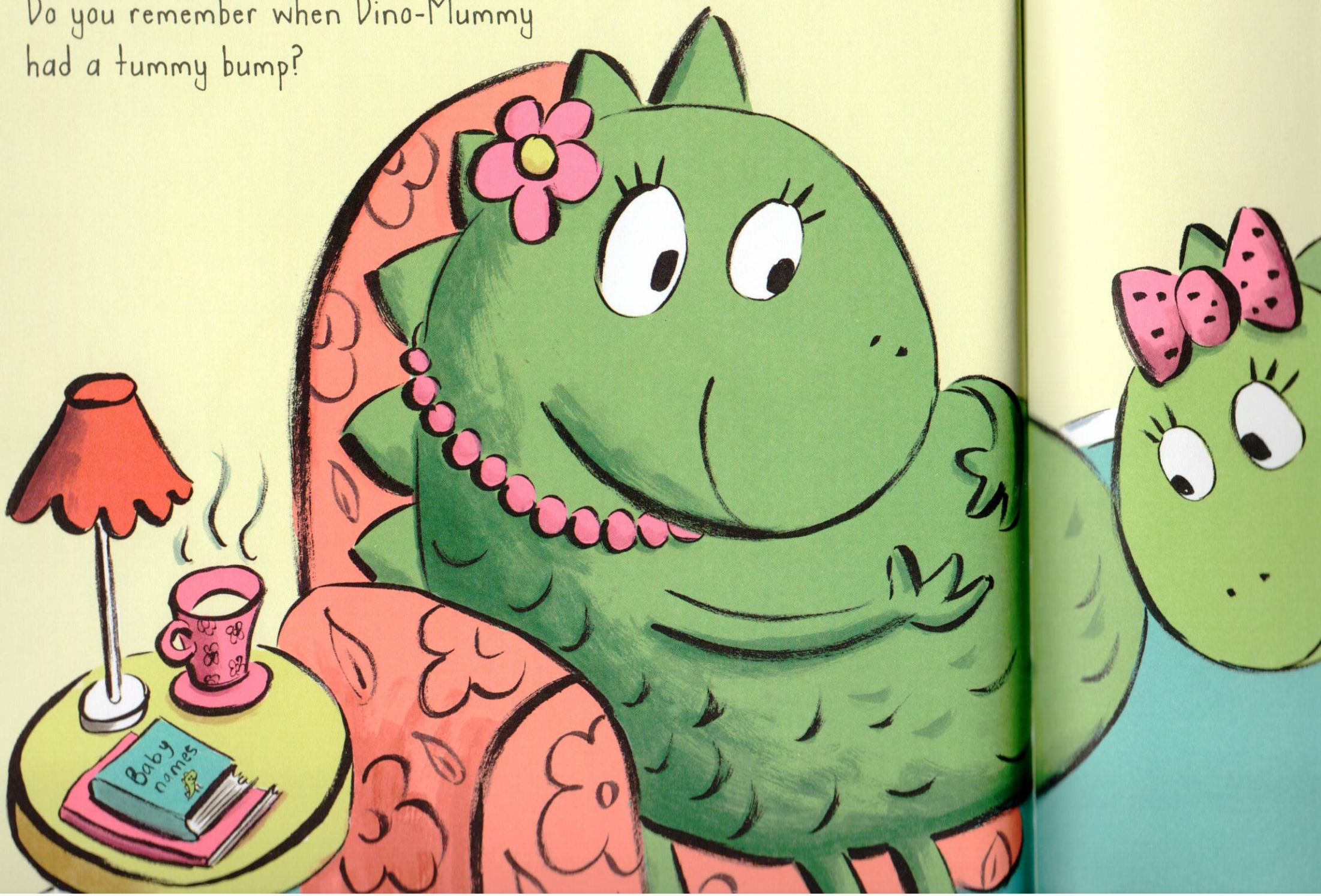


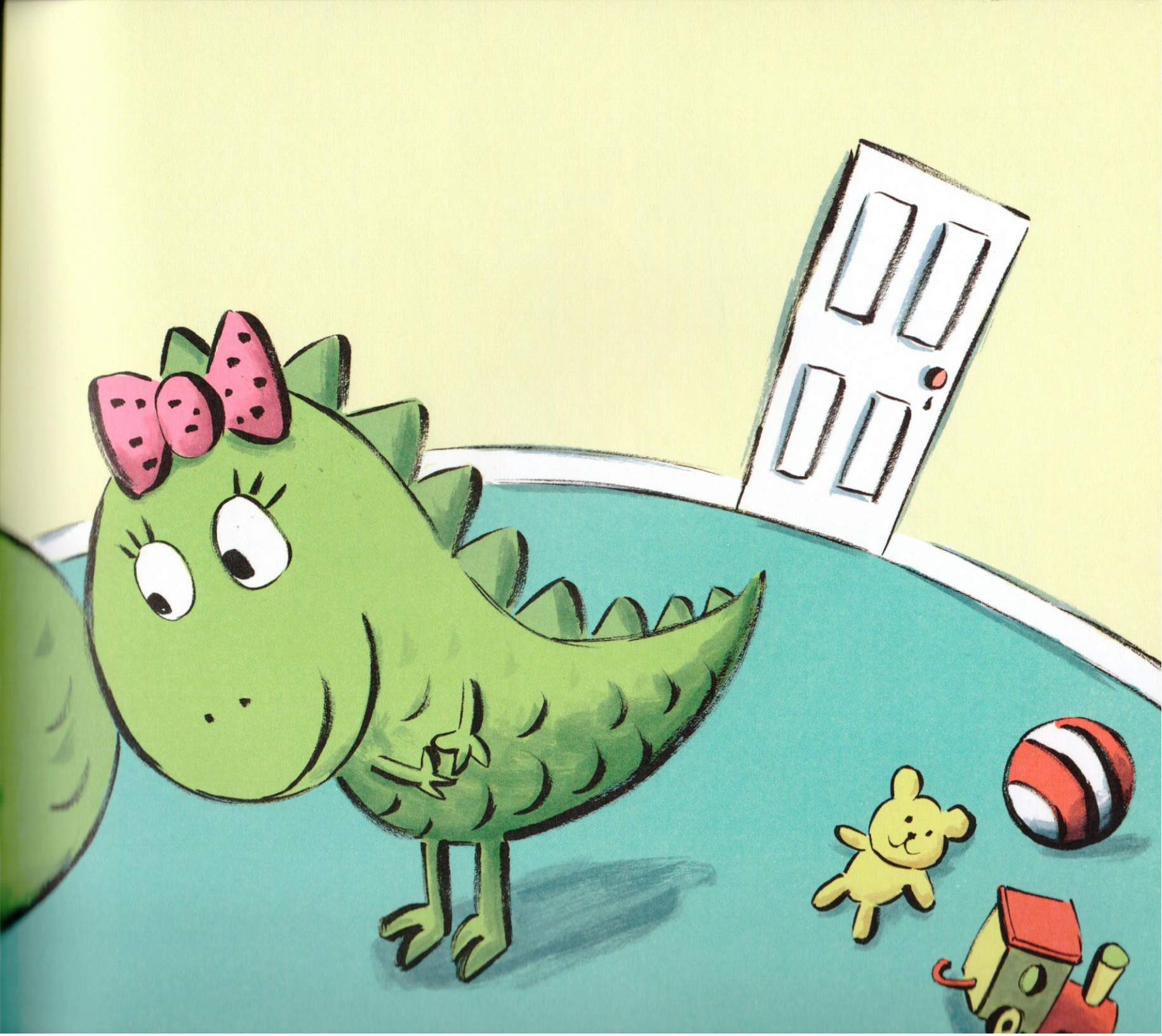

crashes

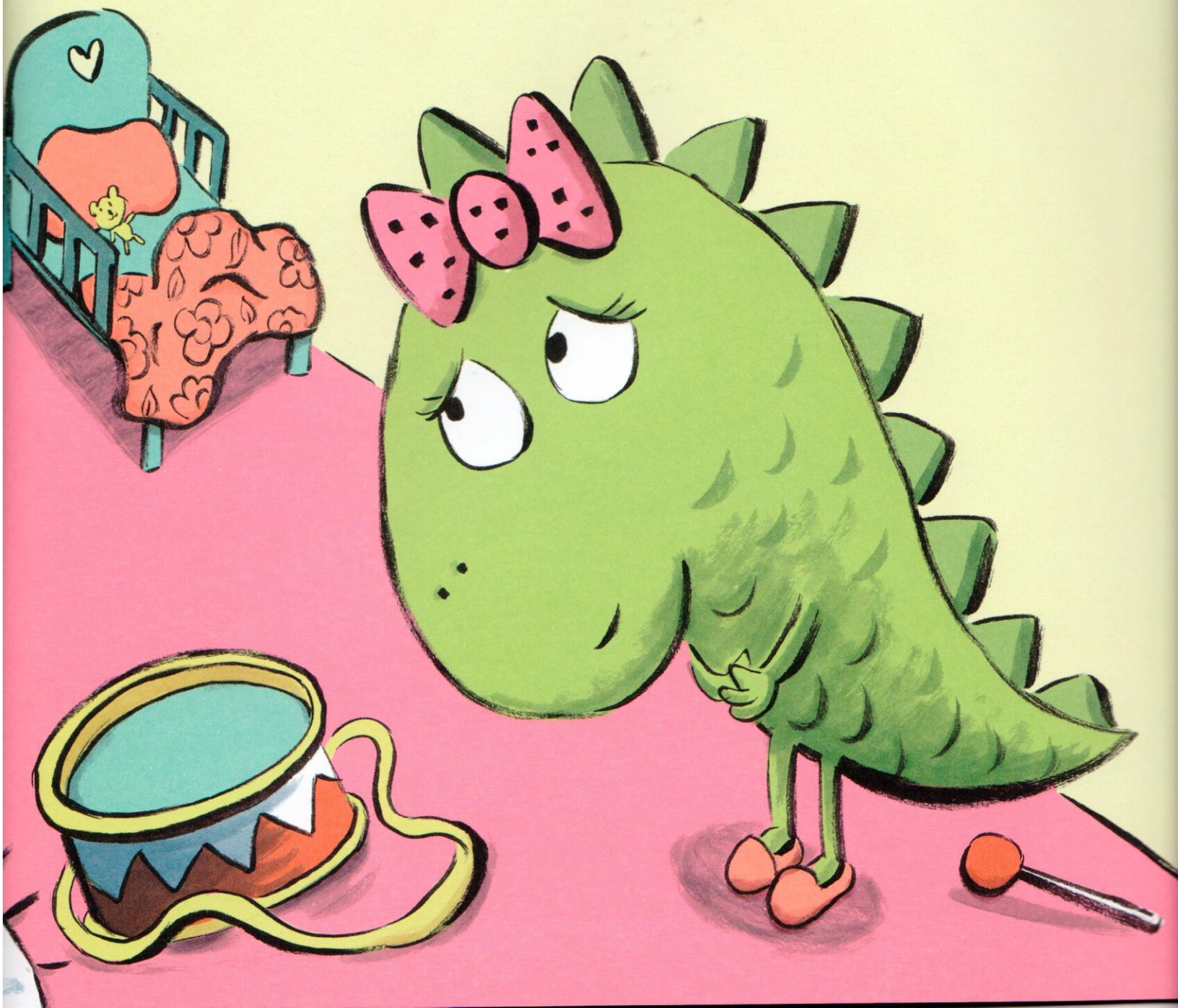
will wake our dino-pup.







shhshhshh!





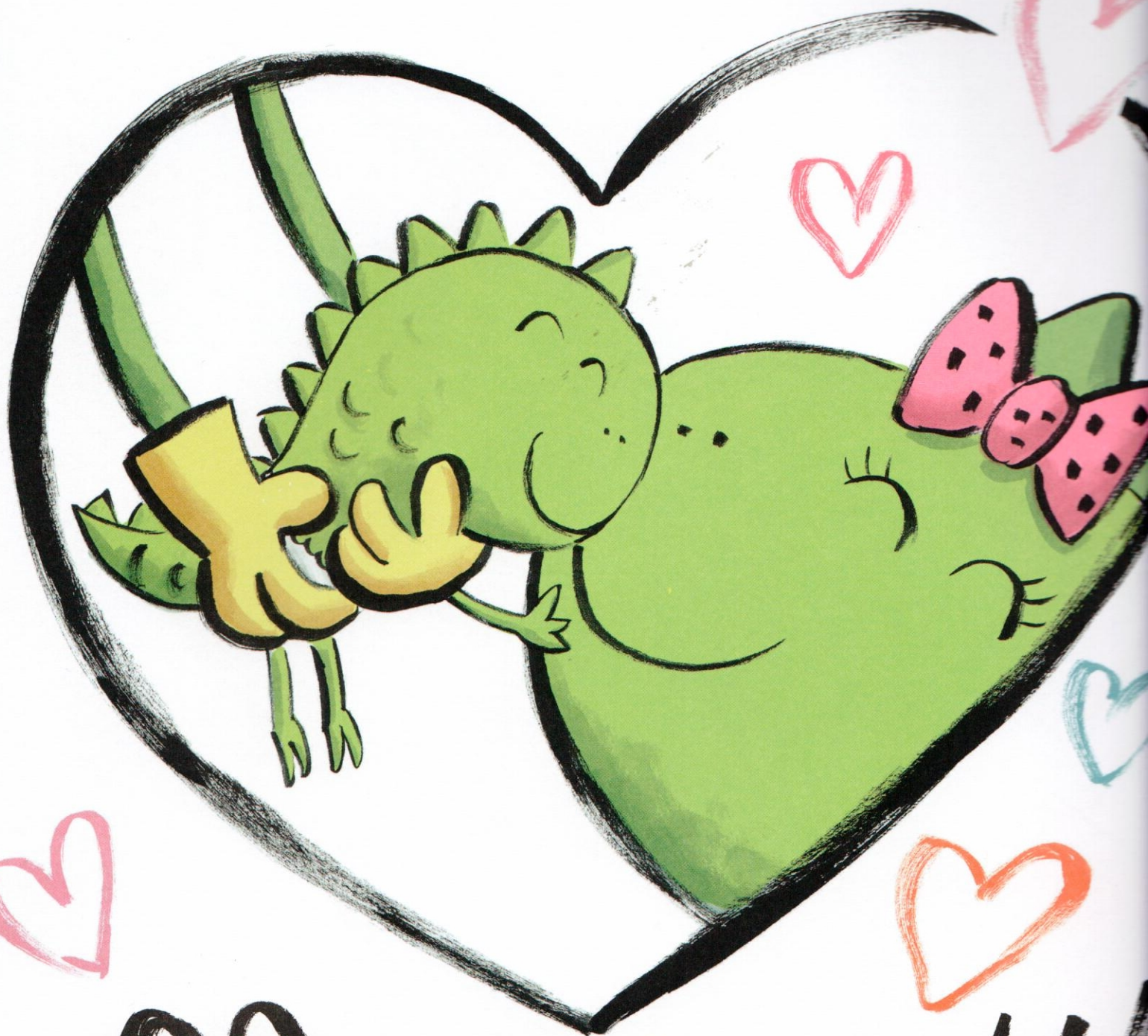
Don't play rough and tumble

Don't snatch things away.



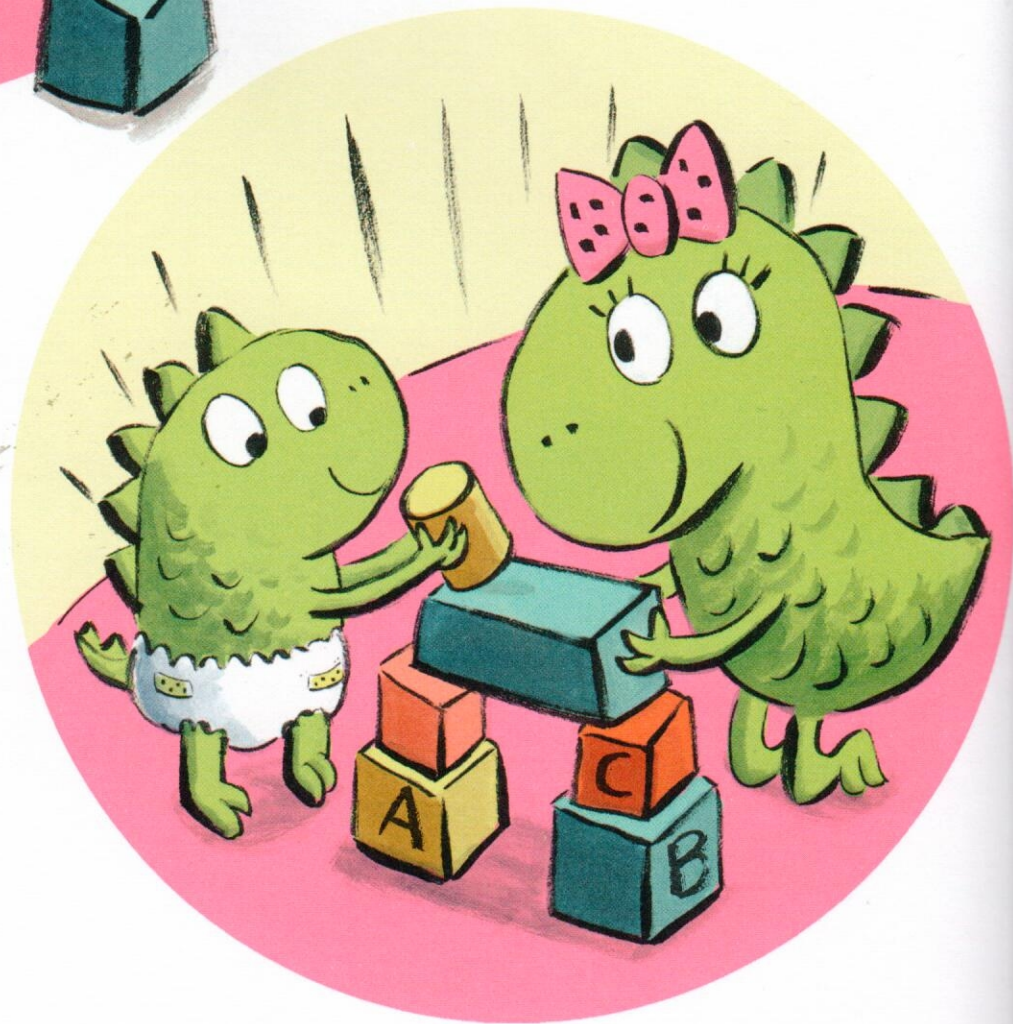


And always try to share.

fun and fair.

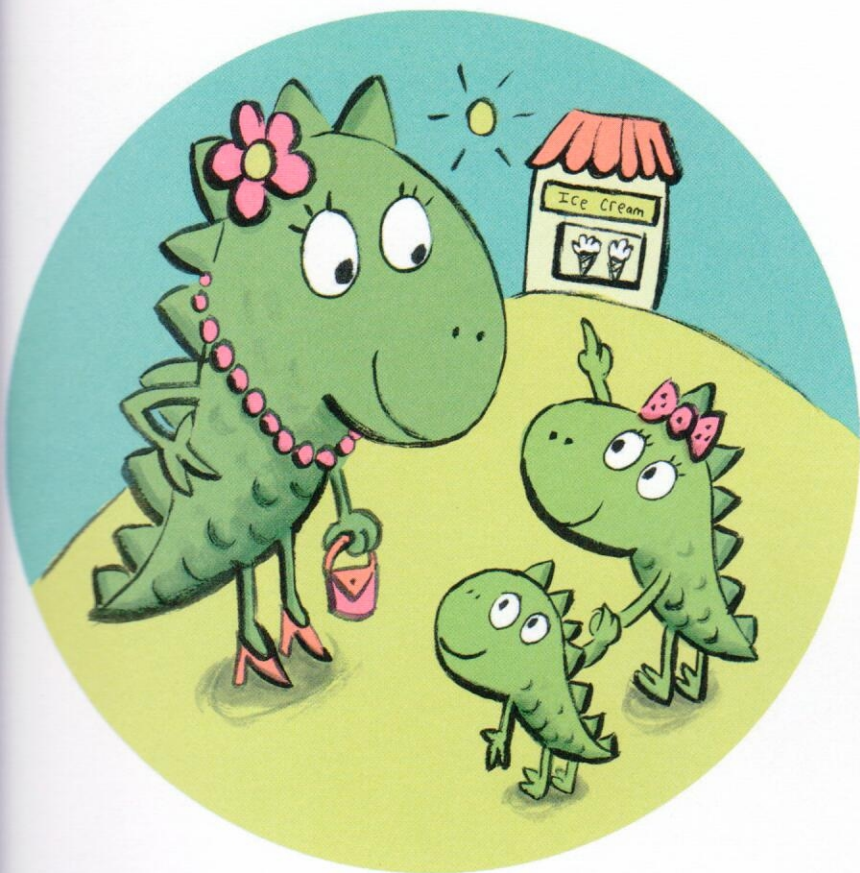






Toot! Toot!

"please"

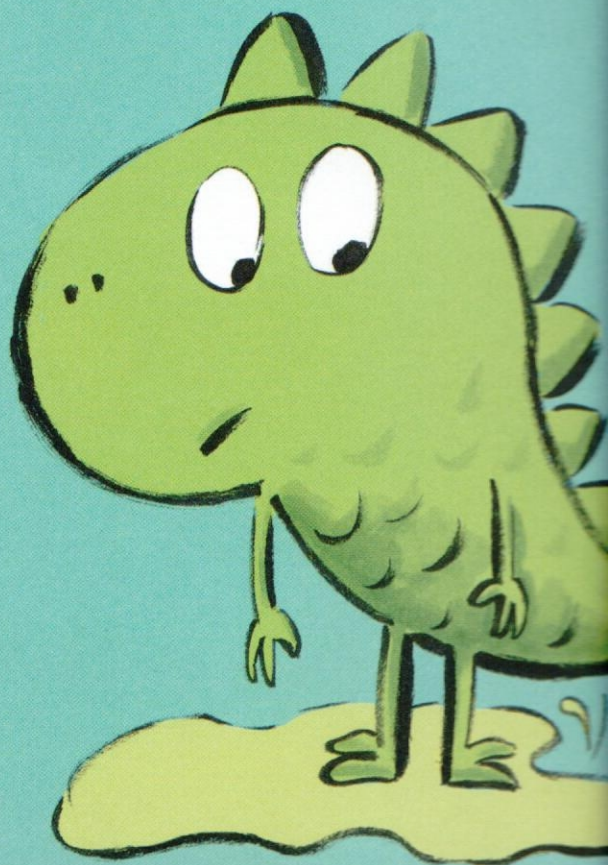
and

say, "Shhhh! Don't make a sound."

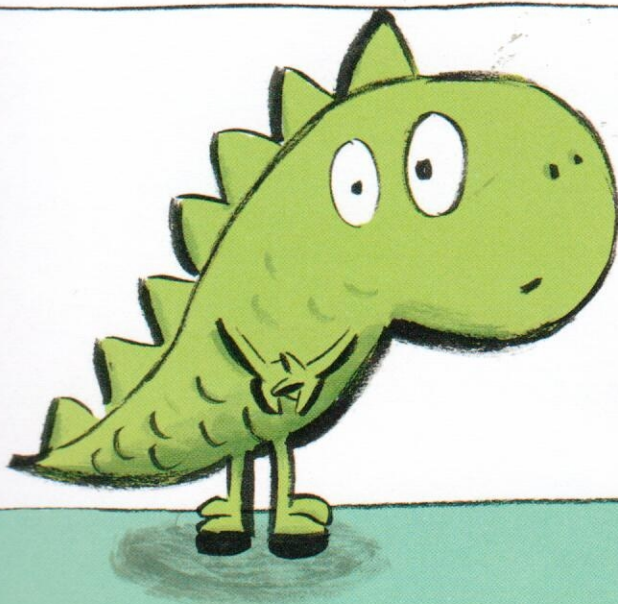
