spots...

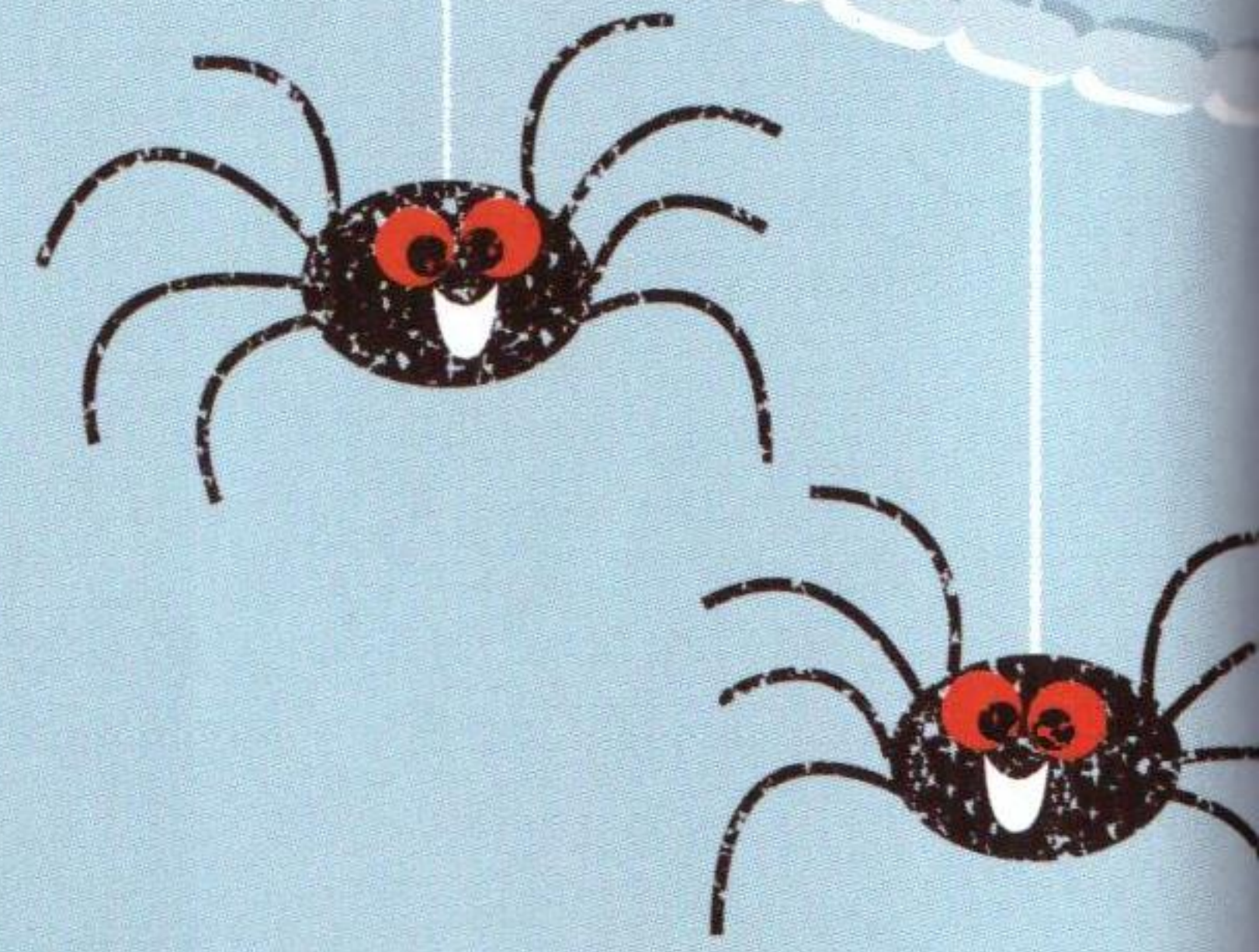
and dots.

run three jolly llamas.

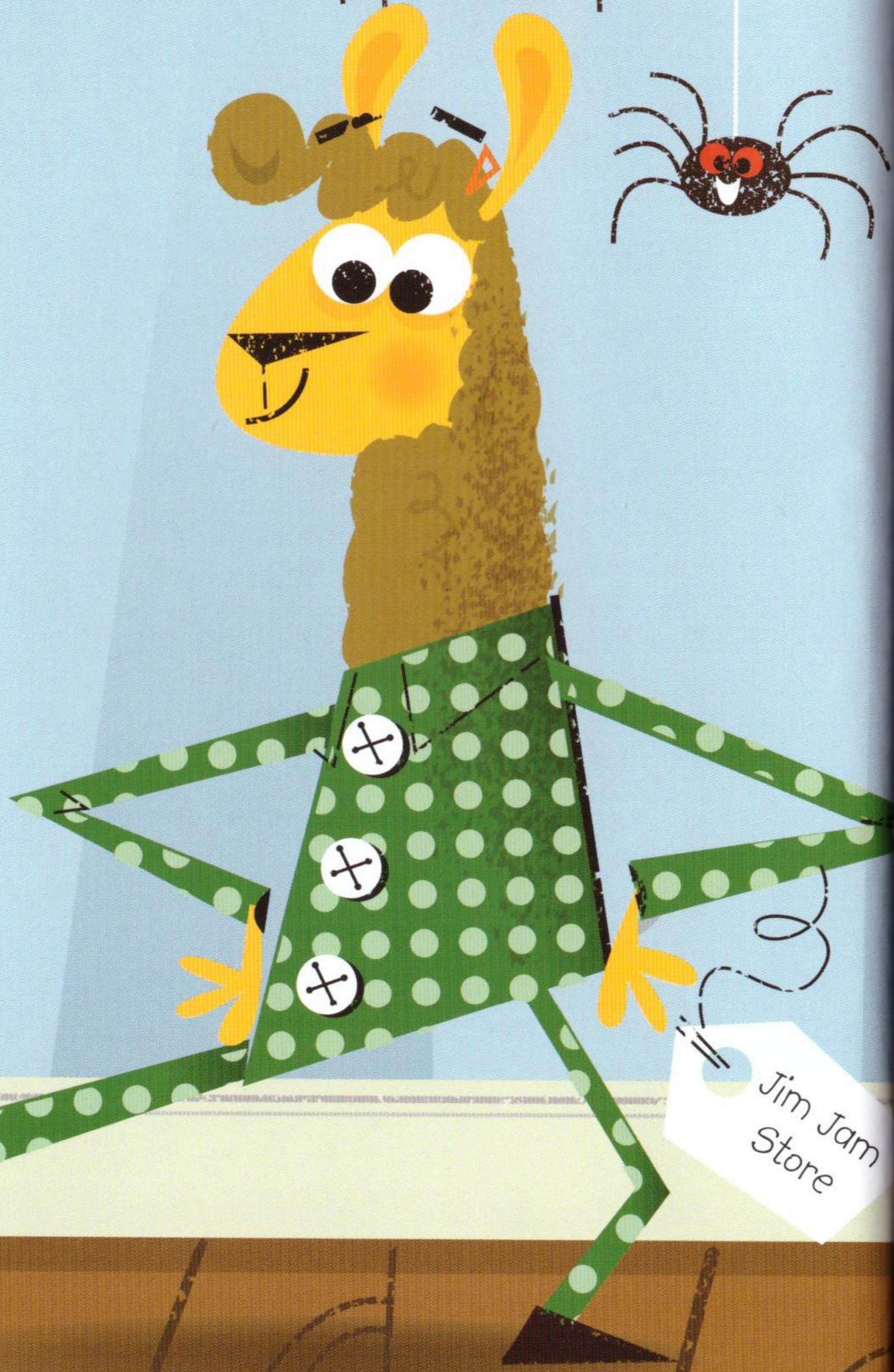


“Hi guys!” shouts Frankie.

Sam's pair is frilly.

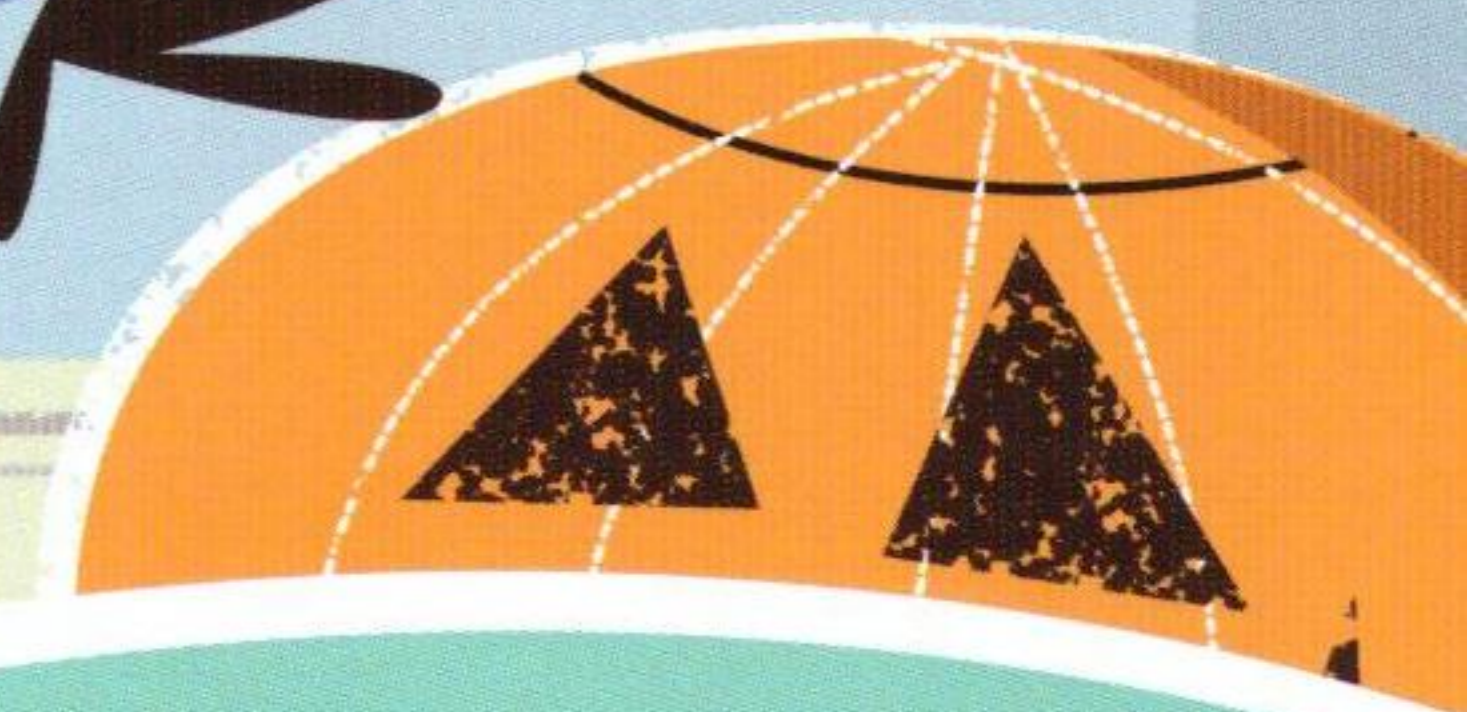


Ali's are new.
